

# Math Teacher Study Tips

1. Do ALL the homework problems on the night you had the class.
2. Review and re-do the homework assignments. (Students might consider doing this the night before the coming class. If they completed the homework the night they received it, then the review will take much less time.)
3. Pre-read the section before class and again before you begin your homework.
4. Rather than study for hours, block your time in reasonable chunks. Try 30 minutes of studying followed by a 5-minute break and then another 30 minutes of studying.
5. When you've completed all the problems, check your homework against the answers in the back of the book (if that's possible). If you missed a few, try to rework the problem to see if you can get it right.
6. Ask specific questions in class about what you didn't understand about a given problem in the homework. The key to understanding a problem is not the answer, it's getting the steps correct.
7. Study for tests!! (Actually do math problems, read your notes, and correct them when they are in error.)
8. Come to Tutorial!!
