## **Senior Soundings**

### **Graduation Rehearsal**

All Graduating Seniors must come to the graduation rehearsal on Tuesday, June 16<sup>th</sup>, beginning at 9 am in the NHS Theater.

### **Graduation Day**

All Graduating Seniors must show up to the NHS gym and check in by 2:30 on Wednesday, June 17<sup>th</sup>, to load onto the busses that will go to the UCI Bren Center.

### **Senior Cap and Gown and Grad Ticket Distribution Schedule**

The remaining caps and gowns will be handed out at the senior breakfast. If you do not go to the senior breakfast you may pick them up at the SAC until Tuesday.

### **Senior Textbook Return**

Seniors must return their textbooks to the Media Center. **Do not have the students return the textbooks to the teacher or class.** Students may return books earlier if the Teacher approves. However, the Deadline is June 12.

If the textbooks are not returned by the specified time, a list of students with outstanding fines will be generated and sent to Administration and Counseling. Fines are to be paid in the Media Center. Fines are for Lost Textbooks, Damaged Textbooks, Lost Library books, Damaged Library books. **No Checks. Cash and Money orders are acceptable.**

A list of students who have outstanding fines and books will be posted on the windows of the Media Center. If a student's name is **NOT** on the list, they have cleared this step for receiving their Diploma. The List will be posted on June 15 and updated daily.

If a student's name **IS** on the list, they must clear up any lost textbooks and/or fines in the Media center by 4 pm on June 16. Students with their names remaining on the list will have their diplomas pulled. Students will not receive their diplomas until their fines are paid and/or books are returned.

To receive the pulled diploma, a student must go to the Media center to clear up any lost textbooks, overdue textbooks and/or fines. Once cleared, the student will be eligible to receive their diploma
