Fall Student-Parent-Teacher Advisor Conferences:

October 11th, 12th, 13th, 14th and 15th

These 20-minute conferences are designed to give you the opportunity to get to know your student's advisor. The conference is loosely structured to allow for conversations that address goals, planning, and / or questions that you and your student may want to address.

Students will be on a Minimum Day Schedule October 11th - 14th. Friday, October will be a regular schedule day. We will maintain our Odd / Even day calendar with class periods reduced to 55 minutes. There will be a Break but we will not be providing lunch options Monday through Thursday.

Parent-Student-Advisor Conferences and State Testing:

May 16th, 17th, 18th, 19th, and 20th.

The Minimum Day Schedule this week allows for course instruction, California Standards and Achievement Tests, along with 20-minute Parent-Student-Advisor conferences.

State testing will occur at the start of the day on Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday followed by course instruction. Monday will be devoted entirely to course instruction. Conferences will run throughout the afternoons and evenings and will be devoted to course selection for the sophomore year. Teacher recommendations and student performance will be the substantive factors in building the sophomore schedule. (Remember, teachers make recommendations based on work completed through the first week of May.)
