

Northwood High School ASB Scholarship 2007-2008

The Scholarship

The purpose of the Scholarship is to recognize two worthy and deserving seniors at Northwood High School who have exhibited academic excellence, involvement in extracurricular activities, and leadership qualities.

Eligibility

The candidates for the Scholarship will need to meet the following qualifications:

- Northwood High School graduating seniors.
- Students who are planning to enroll full time at an accredited community college, college, or university.
- Outstanding students who show a commitment to academics.
- Students with a demonstrated record of community service and leadership.

Awards

Two scholarships of \$1000 will be awarded.

Selection

Recipients are selected without regard to race, color, creed, religion, sex, handicap, or national origin.

Applicants will be reviewed by a committee appointed by the NHS ASB. Finalists will be invited to an interview for further screening.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

To be considered for the scholarship, you must:

- Completely fill out and sign the application.
- Write the specified short essays.
- Arrange for 2 letters of recommendation to be submitted along with your application.
- Have your official transcript to be forwarded with your application.
- Submit your application packet to the S.A.C.

All materials must be submitted by 3:30 PM Wednesday, May 7th 2008 to the S.A.C.

Applications will be reviewed by a scholarship committee appointed from the ASB cabinet. Finalists will be invited to interview for further screening.

I understand that the information provided will not be disclosed beyond the scholarship committee except for cases of verification from NHS counselors, teachers, or administration.
