DEAR NORTHWOOD HIGH SCHOOL PARENTS AND STUDENTS:

Please **read** and **sign** the following contract. It outlines all pertinent information about the dance and expected behavior for all students. The 2008 Prom will take place at Soka University, June 7th, 8:00-12:00 PM.

TICKET SALES: Student must have a completed, signed contract and CURRENT school ID to purchase ticket.

Seniors must purchase their ticket with CASH ONLY!

No exchanges or add-ons – each ticket purchase is final!

Monday, May 5 through Friday May 9

ASB Card: \$65 per ticket; Student ID Card: \$70 per ticket

Monday, May 12 through Friday May 16

ASB Card: \$70 per ticket; Student ID Card: \$75 per ticket

Monday, May 19 through Friday May 23

ASB Card: \$70 per ticket; Student ID Card: \$75 per ticket

Tuesday, May 27 through Friday, May 30

ASB Card: \$75 per ticket; Student ID: Card \$80 per ticket

Monday, June 2 through **Thursday** June 5

ASB Card: \$80 per ticket; Student ID: Card \$85 per ticket

PLEASE NOTE THAT THERE WILL BE ABSOLUTELY NO TICKET SALES AFTER JUNE 5! ALL SALES ARE FINAL (NO REFUNDS).

A NORTHWOOD HIGH SCHOOL IDENTIFICATION CARD IS REQUIRED FOR ADMISSION AND TICKET PURCHASE.

All non-Northwood students must have an administrator's signature from their school,

a valid school or state issued photo ID and must be accompanied by a Northwood student in order to be admitted to the dance.

Guests must be under the age of 21 and in at least 9th grade.

DRESS CODE will be strictly enforced. Anyone in violation will not be admitted. Students in clothing which is extremely brief, excessively form fitting or low-cut (including plunging neck lines, bare midriffs, exposed undergarments, unitards and very short skirts or shorts) will be asked to leave. If clothing becomes altered during the dance, students will receive one warning before being asked to leave. **No refunds will be given.**

RAVE PARAPHERNALIA – Per DISTRICT POLICY, no glow sticks, glowing mouthpieces, beads, flashing lights or pacifiers will be allowed into the dance. **If paraphernalia emerges during the dance, paraphernalia will be confiscated, Saturday School will be assigned, parents will be notified, and students will be barred from the next NHS Dance.**

Dance Floor Guidelines: Dancing styles that involve dancing back to front requires all dancers must remain upright (90° to the floor)—no squatting or bending is allowed for any sustained time while dancing. This includes no dancing with hands on knees or on the dance floor with buttocks facing or touching dance partner(s). Inappropriate bodily contact will not be tolerated while attending a Northwood High School function. Below are consequences for such behavior:

First violation = ID confiscated to be claimed from administrator after the dance.

Second Violation = Immediate removal from dance floor and parents are called for early pick up. Future dance attendance will be considered by administrator. No refund will be given for the cost of the ticket. Incident will be documented in a discipline file.

NHS upholds the IUSD zero tolerance policy. Any students suspected of drinking alcohol will be subject to a Breathalyzer test. Students found under the influence, will be suspended immediately. The rules in the Dance Contract herein are a supplement to Northwood High School's and Irvine Unified School District's broad, discretionary authority to maintain safety, order and discipline inside the school zone or on premises of off-site school events. These rules support, but do not limit, our authority. Students are discouraged from bringing any valuables that will not remain on their person throughout the duration of the dance. These items are often stowed in the gym or in a corner and later reported lost, stolen or vandalized. NHS and IUSD are in no way responsible for lost, stolen or vandalized items.

Latest arrival time to the dance will be one hour after opening. No refunds if the arrival time is missed, no re-admittance once student has left. Students are expected to be picked up from the dance by 12:15 am. **To honor the time of the NHS staff, we ask parents to plan accordingly.** In case of an infraction involving a minor, a parent will be contacted to pick up their student from the dance. In the event that they can't be reached, the incident will be referred to the Irvine Police Department.
